Q. If my mobility means I cannot carry a chair, are there any chairs provided by the festival?

A. We do not supply chairs, but we will help you carry your chair from your vehicle. Just let our staff know that you need assistance.

Q. If my mobility means I cannot sit on the ground or in a low chair, is there someplace I can set up an ordinary height chair? My wheelchair is definitely not low to the ground, is there someplace I can sit in it, where I won't be in the way?

A. Yes, we have a tented seating area for handicapped individuals and we also can accommodate visitors on a case-by-case basis. Please ask for assistance when you arrive.

Q. Is there somewhere I can access electricity to operate medical equipment?

A. Our 24-hour medical emergency service tent is equipped with electricity and certified staff who can assist you. The medical tent is located on the midway and is accessible by wheelchair.

Q. Is there a path from parking to seating which is navigable in a wheelchair or on crutches?

A. Yes, weather permitting. It is up a short incline. We will have a shuttle for handicapped persons. Please ask for assistance upon arrival and please factor in an additional 30 minutes to maneuver from HC parking to the stage area by shuttle. If you have someone with you who can help you maneuver the "hill" that would speed things up.

Q. Is there a path that is kept clear of crowding?

A. Our Security, Traffic and Safety and Emergency Services do their best to keep a path to the amphitheatre clear. Also, while busy at times, vendor row can be navigated well (again, weather permitting).

Q. Can volunteers be arranged to help me? Should I make arrangements ahead of time?

A. We have volunteers who can assist you. We prefer that you notify us in advance. Please email us or call 603-677-2178 to let us know your needs. On site, please stop in at the Medical Tent and ask for assistance.

Q. Where can I park? Is the signage obvious?

A. Our HC Parking area is marked. Upon arrival, ask for a Handicapped Parking pass and after getting your wristband, proceed to HC parking. Our traffic and safety volunteers will direct you to the parking area. It is in the same location as Performer Parking—as close to the stage as we can get you by car.

Q. Are there accessible toilets and handwashing facilities?

A. Yes, they are located near HC camping & HC parking and in the Main Stage area.

Q. Is there a medical facility?

A. Yes, we provide a 24-hour Emergency Medical Tent manned by qualified EMTs, Paramedics and nurses. It is located on Vendor Row on the ROAD side of the vendors, close to HC parking. It is well marked on the map in the program book.
